The direct, linear channelization of Rose Creek isn't adequately addressed, especially with the hard surface channel design of Alternative 2. The correct course of action would be to demo hardscape on the boat <sup>of De Anza</sup> and <sup>increasing</sup> elevation of subtidal areas <sup>in the planning area,</sup> to ensure that future marsh can exist under the highest sea level rise scenarios.
